

- **Retrieval** Whether it is a robot or a shuttle, each solution offers an automated retrieval of ordered products.
- Delivery to goods-to-person (GTP) station One of the main benefits
 of an AS/RS system is products are delivered to a GTP station where
 a worker will consolidate the order, eliminating the need to walk the
 warehouse floor fulfilling orders.
